Chains

The south boundary of the township was surveyed by S. W. Foreman in 1871 and 1872 and was resurveyed by Veigt and Gill in 1916. The south four miles of the east boundary were surveyed by S. W. Foreman in 1872 and resurveyed by B. J. Kinsey in 1934. The north two miles were surveyed by Kinsey in 1934. The west boundary was surveyed by S. W. Foreman in 1871. The south five miles were resurveyed by H. D. Voigt in 1916; however, no iron post monuments were set. The $W_{\frac{1}{2}}$ of the north boundary was surveyed by S. W. Foreman in 1872. The $W_{\frac{1}{2}}$ was resurveyed and the $W_{\frac{1}{2}}$ surveyed by B. J. Kinsey in 1929.

The township was partially subdivided by S. W. Foreman in 1872. The subdivision was completed and a portion of the NE. cor. of the township was resurveyed by Forrest and Wakeman in 1946. The four boundaries of sec. 28 were resurveyed by B. J. Kinsey in 1938.

The record of the 1916 resurvey of the south boundary of the township shows that the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. monuments on the south boundaries of secs. 32, 33 and 34 were marked for corners of maximum control. The marks have been deleted on the $S_{\frac{1}{2}}$ of these iron posts. They now refer to the secs. to the north only.

The survey was executed with a W. and L. E. Gurley solar transit, serial No. 541332, constructed in accordance with the standard instrumental specifications of the Bureau of Land Management. The instrument was in good condition and placed in proper adjustment prior to the beginning of the survey. The azimuths of the lines were established and checked by the direct solar method from time to time throughout the survey.

Measurements were made with a Chicago steel tape, 8 chains in length graduated every 1/10 link for the first link, every link for the next 99 links and every 10 links thereafter. The tape was tested by comparison with a standard tape and found correct. Measurements were made on the slope, and the vertical angle of each interval was ascertained by a clinometer in good adjustment. The horizontal equivalents only are entered in this field note record.

The following transcribed field notes are those of the resurvey of the west boundary and a portion of the subdivision, T. $7 N_{\bullet}$, R. $4 W_{\bullet}$

On January 22, 1957, at 9:30 a.m., at the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, on the north boundary of the township, the following direct solar observation was made:

General Description

The major portion of this township is rolling, rocky ridges and spurs, with scattered to medium dense undergrowth of brush and very poor grass. There is some limited-scale farming along the banks of the Hassayampa River even though the river is dry most of the year.

There is some mining activity in the township. U. S. Highway Nos. 60, 70, and 89, bisects the SW. portion, and there are numerous roads leading from the highway out through the township. The major portion of the people living within the boundaries live along the Hassayampa River bottom. There is a natural gas line running parallel to the highway to serve the city of Wickenburg, Arizona, which is just west of the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the west bdy.

The A. T. and S. F. Railroad parallels the Hassayampa River through the township.
