Chains

The west boundary was surveyed concurrently under this same group and the record appears in the field notes of  $T.\ 30\ N.,\ R.\ 20\ W.$ 

The following transcribed field notes are those of the survey of the south boundary and a portion of the subdivision to help facilitate the location of the Lake Mead Recreation Area boundary, which is defined by the Bureau of Reclamation as being approximately six miles from the center line of the Colorado River. The north and east boundaries were not surveyed.

For the test of the equipment and methods used, see the notes for T. 29 N., R. 18 W., of this group.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of this township is latitude 35° 56' 17" N. and longitude 114° 15' 49" W. The mean magnetic declination is 15° East.
