#### Chains

The four boundaries of this township were surveyed by T. F. White in 1874 and 1875; the subdivisional lines were surveyed by T. F. White in 1875, as represented on the plat approved March 31, 1875. The east boundary was resurveyed be W. B. Kimmel in 1914, as represented on the plat of T. 8 S., R. 28 E., approved June 19, 1915.

The resurvey of the north boundary is provided for in the notes of T. 7 S., R. 27 E. of this group. The resurvey of the west boundary is provided for in the resurvey of T. 8 S., R. 26 E. of group 299.

For the test of the instruments and methods used, see the notes for  $T.\ 7\ S.,\ R.\ 27\ E.$  of this group.

The following transcribed field notes are those of the resurvey of the south boundary and a portion of the subdivision. The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is latitude 32° 41' 11.177" N., and longitude  $109^{\circ}$  31' 39.659" W. The mean magnetic declination is  $13\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E.

Dependent Resurvey of the South Boundary of T. 8 S., R. 27 E.

No original corners were found for the six miles of this boundary, therefore, the corners are set at proportionate distance from the corner of Ts. 8 and 9 S., Rs. 27 and 28  $\pm$ ., which is monumented with an iron post set, marked, and witnessed as described in the official recrod.
