Chains

The west boundary was surveyed by Otis Ross in 1915-16, as represented on the plat of T. 14 N., R. 12 W. The east boundary of the township was surveyed by W. H. Thorn and Ty White in 1923, as represented on the plat of T. 14 N., R. 10 W.

The following field notes are those of the survey of the south and north boundaries, and of the subdivision of T. 14 N., R. 11 W.

The survey was executed with a W. and L. E. Gurley solar transit, serial No. 541328, which conforms to the standard instrumental specifications of the Bureau of Land Management. The instrument was maintained in precise adjustment throughout the progress of the survey.

The measurements were made with a narrow steel tape, 8 chains in length, graduated to tenths of links for the first link, to links for the next 99 links and thereafter at intervals of 10 links. The tape was tested by comparison with a standard steel tape, 1 chain in length and found correct. The measurements were made on the slope and the vertical angle of each interval was ascertained by two clinometers in good adjustment. The slope distances were properly reduced to horizontal equivalents which are entered in the field note record.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is latitude 34° 30' 04'' N. and longitude 113° 21' 31'' W., as determined from data furnished with the special instructions.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be 14° 45' E.
