	The west, north, and the north two miles of the east boundary were surveyed in 1915-1916 by Harris and Gonin. The south boundary was surveyed in 1956 by Smith, Godwin and Harding. Sections 1 through 12 were surveyed in 1916 by Harris and Gonin.
	The following notes are those of the survey of the south four miles of the east boundary and the survey of sections 13 through 36, Township 10 North, Range 16 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.
	This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions, dated March 20, 1961.
	Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these notes. Unless described, all corners were monumented with standard iron posts, 30 inches long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches diameter, flanged at the base and with brass caps riveted to the tops.
	The geographical position of the southeast corner of the township is: Latitude, 34°09'29" North and Longitude, 113°52'10" West. The magnetic declination was found to be 14°45' East.
