Chains

The west half of the north boundary was surveyed in 1916 by Ross and Warner. The east half of the north boundary was surveyed in 1930 by Hiester and Hunter. The east boundary was surveyed in 1926 by Sawyer and Hunter. The south boundary was surveyed in 1958 by Crain. The west boundary was surveyed by Ross and Warner in 1916.

The following notes are those of the survey of the subdivisional lines of Township 15 North, Range 11 West, and the dependent resurvey of the east bdy. of sec. 36, Township 15 North, Range 12 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions, dated November 4, 1960.

Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these notes. Unless described, all corners were monumented with standard iron posts, 30 inches long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter, flanged at the bases and with brass caps riveted to the tops. Original corner monuments were deposited alongside the new monuments, unless described otherwise.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is: Latitude, 34°35'25" North, and Longitude, 113°21'16" West. The magnetic declination was found to be 15°15' East.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION
