The north and west boundaries were surveyed in 1875 by T. F. White. The south and east boundaries were surveyed in 1885 by L. Wolfley. The subdivisional lines were surveyed in 1885 by J. C. Smith. The west boundary was resurveyed in 1904 by P. Contzen. The north boundary was resurveyed in 1957 by D. E. Harding. The south boundary was concurrently resurveyed under Group No. 351 Arizona.

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of the east and west boundaries and the subdivisional lines of T.9S., R.27E., and a retracement of a portion of the north boundary.

This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated August 10, 1960.

Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in the notes. Unless described, all corners were monumented with standard iron posts, 30 inches long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter, flanged at the bases and with brass caps riveted to the tops.

The geographic position for the southeast corner of the township is in latitude $32^{\circ}36^{\circ}01.115^{\circ}$ N. and longitude $109^{\circ}31^{\circ}40.110^{\circ}$ W. as determined by direct tie to U.S.C.& G.S. triangulation station "Tan" located in section 36.

The magnetic declination was read at a number of stations throughout the township and the average of these readings was found to be 13° East.

	General Description
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T. 9 S., R. 27 E., is located in the northern portion of San Simon Valley of Graham County, Arizona, with the northwest corner of the township being four and one-half miles east of the village of Artesia, Arizona.

The land within T. 9 S., R. 27 E., is low rolling to nearly level with a general northeast slope. The elevation of the township ranges from about 3,200 feet above sea level along the bottom of San Simon Wash in section 2 to about 3,700 feet above sea level in the southwest quarter of section 31.

The drainage system of the township is a rejuvenated system, composed of intermittent streams and washes. San Simon Wash, the main stream in the valley, has cut-banks which average about 20 feet high throughout its length. The San Simon enters the township at the southeast corner, draining northerly across the township to leave at a point near the quarter section corner of sections 2 and 35 on the north boundary. The remainder of the drainage is smaller washes, with cut-banks which are one or two feet high at their heads, but some are as high as 20 feet where the washes join the San Simon.

There are two types of soil found in the township. Along the stream valley of the San Simon there is a deep, well-developed loam. With the rejuvenation of the drainage system and the consequent lowering of the water table this soil produces nothing and appears as a mud flat and is being rapidly eroded and carried downstream. The remainder and major portion of the soil found in the township is a rocky, sandy clay which supports a vegetation cover of mesquite and catclaw trees, creosote bush, cacti and grasses. The creosote bush, cacti and grasses are found over most of the area, while the mesquite and catclaw trees are found mostly along the dry stream bed.

Chains

A branch line of the Southern Pacific Railroad crosses the township from a point near the quarter section corner of sections 1 and 36 on the south boundary to a point near the quarter section corner of sections 2 and 35 on the north boundary. An improved dirt road crosses the township from a point near the quarter section corner of section 30 on the west boundary, in an easterly direction, to a point near the quarter section corner of sections 1 and 36 on the south boundary. There are enough track roads scattered throughout the township so that any portion can be reached easily.

The only source of water with any apparent permanence is that produced from a well by the windmill located in section 26. There are numerous stock ponds scattered throughout the township and there are a few natural ponds along the bottom of the San Simon Wash. The only improvements other than those noted are the cabin, shed, tank and corral located at the well in section 26 and the range fences along allotment boundaries.

There is no evidence of any mineralization in the area of T. 9 S., R. 27 E., and at the present time the only apparent interest and utilization of the land and its resources is in access, cattle grazing and some small game hunting.
