CHAINS

The Arizona area involved in this work, Ts85, Rs22-23W, G&SRM, was surveyed in 1874 by T. F. White. A portion was resurveyed and accretion land surveyed in 1949 by D. R. Averill. Dependent resurveys were made in 1960-61 under the direction of Robert Yundt.

The California area involved in this work, Ts16S, Rs22-23E, SBM, was surveyed in 1856 by John LaCroze. The townships were resurveyed in 1895 by Frank S. Ingalls. A portion was resurveyed and accretion land surveyed in 1949 by D. R. Averill. The townships were dependently resurveyed in 1960-61 under the direction of Robert Yundt.

The following field notes are those of the establishment of Points Nos. 20 through 31 of the Boundary between Arizona and California in Ts8S, Rs22-23W, G&SRM, Arizona, and Ts16S, Rs22-23E, SBM, California, as defined in the Compact between the States, dated March 12, 1963. At the time of these surveys the Compact had not been approved by Congress. In anticipation that the Compact will be approved, all corner points established have been marked with State names in appropriate positions.

The establishment of these points was made in accordance with the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated February 6, 1964.

The determination of the geodetic position of these points and the survey and description of the Boundary are responsibilities of the United States Coast and Geodetic Survey, as more particularly set out in the Compact.

The magnetic declination was found to be 13°45' East.

Establishment of Point No. 20

The Compact describes Point No. 20 as follows:

Point No. 20, which lies on the centerline of the Colorado River where said centerline intersects the section line between Sections 4 and 9, Township 8 South, Range 22 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian; • • •

Point No. 20 was established in the following manner:

From the WP on the line bet. secs. 4 and 9, T8S, R22W, on the left (east) bank of the Colorado River, which is a regulation iron post, set and marked as described in the record of the 1961 resurveys.

Thence

N. 89°53' W., on a projection of the line bet. secs. 4 and 9, across the Colorado River. The distance between the left and right banks is 14.38 chs.; the midpoint or centerline of the river is at 7.19 chs. dist. on this line.

CHAINS

It being impracticable to monument Point No. 20 within the river, set an iron post 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, in a secure place on top of the right bank, as a witness point on the line bet. Points Nos. 20 and 21, with brass cap mkd.

The true point for Point No. 20, in the center of the river and on the line bet. secs. 4 and 9, bears N. 89°13' E., 8.00 chs. dist.

A cottonwood 16 ins. diam., bears South, 5 lks. dist., mkd. WPPT20BT

A cottonwood 18 ins. diam., bears N. 57° E., 89 lks. dist., mkd. WPPT20BT

The cor. of secs. 14, 15, 22 and 23, T16S, R23E, SBM, California, a $2\frac{1}{2}$ in. iron post as described in the official record, bears N. 26°18' W., 17.85 chs. dist.

Set a 4x4-in. wood post, 6 ft. long, 3 ft. in the ground and alongside iron post.

Establishment of Point No. 21

The Compact describes Point No. 21 as follows:

Point No. 21, which will be the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of Section 8, Township 8 South, Range 22 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian,


Point No. 21, being also the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8, T8S, R22W, was established in the following manner:

Since all direct evidence of the original ½ sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 8 has been destroyed by a southerly movement of the Colorado River since the time of the original surveys and the immediate lands are presently surveyed as being within T16S, R23E, San Bernardino Meridian, the point was determined by the projection of existent surveys within T8S, R22W, as shown upon the 1961 official plat, across the area to a theoretical position therefor. The details of this mathematical determination are omitted.

At the point

Set an iron post, 20 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 3 ins. below the surface of a road, cap mkd.

The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 15 and 22, T16S, R23E, SBM, a $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. iron post, set and mkd. as described in the official record, bears N. 4°28' E., 16.51 chs. dist.

The true point for Point No. 20 bears N. 89°13' E., 57.29 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

A farm road intersection with roads W. and S., bears N. $12^{\circ}45^{\circ}$ E., 41 lks. dist.

Set a 4x4 ins. wood post, 5 ft. long, 30 ins. in the ground, West, 10 lks. dist., mkd. RM PT 21 6.7 FT. E.

Establishment of Point No. 22

The Compact describes Point No. 22 as follows:

Point No. 22, which is the northeast corner of the southwest quarter of Section 8, Township 8 South, Range 22 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian,

The point was determined by the projection of existent surveys within T8S, R22W, as shown on the 1961 official plat, across the area to a theoretical position therefor. The details of this mathematical determination are omitted. The immediate lands are presently surveyed as being within T16S, R23E, San Bernardino Meridian, California.

At the point

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, cap mkd.

from which

An iron pipe, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 8 ins. of it above ground with a railroad tie firmly set alongside, bears N. $51^{\circ}43^{\circ}$ W., 1.09 chs. dist.

An iron pipe, 1 inch diam., 6 ins. of it above ground, bears N. 79°26' E., 1.17 chs. dist.

CHAINS

The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27 and 28, San Bernadino Meridian, California, a $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. iron post, set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official notes, bears S. $58^{\circ}09^{\circ}$ W., 45.45 chs. dist.

Point No. 21 bears North 39.78 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by the C&GS)

Establishment of Point No. 23

The Compact describes Point No. 23 as follows:

Point No. 23, which is the west quarter corner of Section 7, Township 8 South, Range 22 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, . . .

The west quarter corner of sec. 7 is monumented by an iron post as described in the official record of the 1949 survey; added marks to brass cap to read

from which

Point No. 22 bears N. $89^{\circ}28^{\circ}$ E., 118.74 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

A railroad tie has been set alongside the iron post and both are under an electric high line bearing N_{\bullet} and S_{\bullet} in cultivated land.

Establishment of Point No. 24

The Compact describes Point No. 24 as follows:

Point No. 24, which is the southwest corner of Section 7, Township 8 South, Range 22 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian,

The southwest corner of sec. 7 is monumented by an iron post as described in the official record of the 1949 survey; added marks to brass cap to read

Point No. 23 bears N. 0°01' W., 40.00 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

Point is under an electric high line bearing N_{\bullet} and S_{\bullet} and in cultivated land.

Establishment of Point No. 25

The Compact describes Point No. 25 as follows:

Point No. 25, which is the southwest corner of Section 12, Township 8 South, Range 23 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian,

The southwest corner of sec. 12 is monumented by an iron post set in concrete, 10 ins. below the surface of the ground, 2 lks. W. of a fence post; added marks to brass cap to read

Point No. 24 bears East, 80.04 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

Set a 4x4 ins. wood post, 5 ft. long, 2 ft. in ground, alongside iron post, on E. side of a field road in cultivated land.

This iron post no longer functions as the monument for the cor. of secs. 11, 12, 13 and 14. (See cancellation of surveys in T8S, R23W.)

Establishment of Point No. 26

The Compact describes Point No. 26 as follows:

Point No. 26, which is the west quarter corner of Section 13, Township 8 South, Range 23 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian,


The west quarter corner of sec. 13 is monumented by a badly bent 2-in. iron post, firmly set, brass cap gone.

At the cor. point

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 12 ins. below surface of road, roads N-S-E, cap mkd.

An iron pipe, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 3 ft. of it above ground, marks pipe line crossing, bears S. **7**°45' E., 0.52 chs. dist.

Point No. 25 bears N. 0°01' W., 40.00 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

Set a 4x4 ins. wood post, 5 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground and alongside iron post, in "Y" of roads in cultivated land.

Establishment of Point No. 27

The Compact describes Point No. 27 as follows:

Point No. 27, which lies on the east shoulder of the north-south road through the Indian School approximately 370 feet due East of the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 22 East, San Bernardino Meridian,

Point No. 27 was established on a line due East from the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of sec. 25, where it intersects the east shoulder of the N-S road through the Indian School.

At the point

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, cap mkd.

from which

Point No. 26 bears N. 88°43' E., 155.58 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

The point for the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of sec. 25 bears West, 3.57 chs. dist. (not monumented).

Set a 4x4 ins. wood post, 4 ft. long, 45 ins. in the ground and alongside the iron post, on the steep east shoulder of a winding N-S road, 1 ft. E. of black top of road.

Establishment of Point No. 28


The Compact describes Point No. 28 as follows:

Point No. 28, which lies on the easterly shoulder line of said north-south road due East of the northeast corner of the stone retaining wall around the Indian School Hospital,

Point No. 28 was established on a line due East of the northeast corner of the stone retaining wall around the Indian School Hospital at its intersection with the easterly shoulder of the winding N-S road through the Indian School.

At the point

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, cap mkd.



from which

Point No. 27 bears N. 2°58' E., 6.95 chs. and N. 19°07' W., 3.98 chs. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

The NE. cor. of the stone retaining wall around the Indian School Hospital bears West, 44 lks. dist.

Set a 4x4 ins. wood post, 4 ft. long, 45 ins. in the ground and alongside iron post, on E. shoulder of winding N-S road, 1 ft. E. of black top on road.

> Establishment of Point No. 29

The Compact describes Point No. 29 as follows:

Point No. 29, which is the base of the northeast corner of said retaining wall,

Point No. 29 was established at the base of the northeast corner of the retaining wall around the Indian School Hospital grounds, on the west side of the N-S winding road through the Indian School, 3 ft. west of the black top on the road.

At the point

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, cap mkd.

from which

Point No. 28 bears East, 0.43 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

Set a 4x4 ins. wood post, 5 ft. long, 2 ft. in the ground and alongside the iron post.

Establishment of Point No. 30

The Compact describes Point No. 30 as follows:

Point No. 30, which lies on the westerly shoulder line of said north-south road 330 feet south of and approximately 110 feet east of the northeast corner of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 22 East, San Bernardino Meridian,

Point No. 30 was established 330 feet south of and 79.2 feet east of the northeast corner of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 22 East, San Bernardino Meridian, California, and on the W. side of overpass for road.

At the point

Drive a roofing nail with flagging in the lower plate of the overpass, mark plate to south of nail, PT NO 30

from which

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, East, 0.46 chs. dist. cap mkd.

30.4 FT RM PT NO 30 ARIZ

Point No. 29 bears N. 17°54' E., 3.01 chs., N. 2°30' E., 6.70 chs., and N. 16°40' E., 5.00 chs.

R.M. is on the **E.** shoulder of N-S road, approximately 10 ft. north of overpass with a 4x4 ins. wood post, 6 ft. long, set 2 ft. in ground alongside the iron post.

Establishment of Point No. 31

The Compact describes Point No. 31 as follows:

Point No. 31, which lies on the east line of Section 35, Township 16 South, Range 22 East, San Bernardino Meridian, exactly 330 feet south of the northeast corner of said Section 35, . . .


Point No. 31 was established on the line between sections 35 and 36, T16S, R22E, SBM, California, 5.00 chs. (330 ft.) S. 0°01' E., from the cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35 and 36, a 2-in. iron post as described in the official record.

Set an iron post 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., flush with surface of a paved road around old depot, cap mkd.

Point No. 30 bears East, 1.20 chs. dist. (Subject to precise determination by C&GS)

Point No. 31 is in the center of the abandoned paved road around the east side of abandoned depot, and approximately 60 lks. SW. of the Santa Fe railroad
