	Township 39 North, Range 2 West Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona
CHAINS	The west boundary of Township 39 North, Range 2 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona, was surveyed in 1914 by J. C. Thoma as shown on the plat of Township 39 North, Range 3 West, accepted October 5, 1950. The east boundary was surveyed in 1916 by Mathews and Nash and shown on the plat of Township 39 North, Range 1 West, approved August 22, 1919. The north boundary was surveyed in 1954 by D. E. Harding and shown on the plat of Township 40 North, Range 2 West, accepted October 25, 1955.
	The following notes are those of a dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary, and survey of the south boundary and subdivisional lines of Township 39 North, Range 2 West, of the Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.
	This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated March 4, 1964.
	Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances are given in these notes. Unless described, each corner was monumented with a standard iron post, 30 inches long, 2½ inches in diameter, flanged at the base, with a brass cap riveted to the top.
	The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is: Latitude 36°43'45.2" North, and Longitude 112°26'55.3" West, as computed from a tie to U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey triangulation station GRAVEL, located in Section 13, Township 39 North, Range 2 West.  The mean magnetic declination was found to be 16°15' East.
