CHAINS

The east boundary, the Arizona-New Mexico State Line, was surveyed in 1875 by C. Robbins and retraced in 1882 by M. Santee. That portion of the boundary from the 167½ mile post to the 171.53 mile post was resurveyed by L. Toland in 1936. Walsh and Bilbray resurveyed from the 171.53 mile post to the 180½ mile post in 1946. The south boundary (the Third Standard Parallel North), the north and west boundaries and subdivisional lines were surveyed in 1882 by M. Santee.

The south boundary, the Third Standard Parallel North, was resurveyed in 1966 by Bauer and Oviatt under Group 443. The west boundary was resurveyed concurrently under this same group by Bauer, Oviatt and Herman. The record thereof is included in the field notes of Township 13 North, Range 30 East.

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of the north boundary and subdivisional lines of fractional Township 13 North, Range 31 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona, designed to restore the corners according to the best available evidence.

This survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated February 16, 1966.

Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these notes. Unless described, each corner was monumented with a standard iron post, 30 inches long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter, flanged at the base, and with a brass cap riveted to the top.

The geographic position of the southeast corner of the township is: Latitude, 34°28'58.8" North, and Longitude, 109°02'45" West. This position was calculated from a direct tie to U.S.C.&G.S. triangulation station "St. Johns," located in sec. 8, T. 12 N., R. 30 E.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be 14° East.
