CHAINS

Township 19 North, Range 8 East. The boundaries and subdivision lines were surveyed by J. L. Harris, Deputy Surveyor, in 1879, as shown upon the official plat, approved November 8, 1879. A number of corners were remonumented by Wallace R. Ott, Surveying Technician, in 1966, accepted February 27, 1968.

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the north boundary and a portion of the subdivision lines, and the survey of a portion of the subdivision lines in sections 4 and 5, Township 19

North, Range 8 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona

Before restoring the corners, the lines of the original survey was retraced and a diligent search made for any evidence of the original corners, bearing trees, and calls of the original field note records. When duly identified the corner positions were remonumented.

The rules of proportionate measurement were applied in order to ascertain the position of lost corners, after completing the necessary retracements to connect the identified corner locations, but not until exhausting every reasonable possibility of finding direct evidence for the control of each particular corner.

The dependent resurvey and survey were executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the special instructions dated February 7, 1967.

The directions of all lines of this survey were determined by direct altitude observation of the sun, for azimuth and carried forward by normal transit traverse. Distances are expressed in chains, reduced to horizontal equivalents.

The data furnished with the special instructions give the geographic position of the corner of sections 3, 4, 9 and 10 as: Latitude 35° 03.0' N., Longitude 111° 32.6' W.

The magnetic declination as obtained by reference to the U. S. Geological Survey map, Lower Lake Mary, Arizona, 1962 is: $14\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E.
