CHAINS

The east and north boundaries, the east three miles of the south boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines were surveyed in 1882 by T. F. White. The west three miles of the south boundary were surveyed and the south boundary of sections 34 and 35 was resurveyed in 1910 by H. F. DuVal. The west boundary was surveyed and the west one and one-half miles of the north boundary were resurveyed in 1931 by C. E. Hunter. The boundaries of section 32 were surveyed and the south boundary of section 32 resurveyed by George M. Boofer in 1956. The west one mile and the east four miles of the south boundary, the south two miles of the east boundary and the west two miles of the north boundary were resurveyed in 1961-62 by Cazier and Murphy, who also completed the survey of the subdivisional lines the same year.

The north boundaries of sections 2 and 3 were resurveyed concurrently under this same group by Herman and Oviatt. The record thereof is included in the field notes of Township 7 South, Range 31 East.

The following notes are those of a dependent resurvey of the north four and one-half miles of the east boundary, the east one-half mile on the south boundary of section 35 and one mile on the south boundary of section 32 and portions of the subdivisional lines, designed to restore the corners in their true original location according to the best available evidence; and, the survey of subdivisions in sections 2, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 23, 25, 27, 32, 34 and 35 of Township 8 South, Range 31 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

This survey was executed in accordance with the Specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the Special Instructions dated December 14, 1967.

Only the true line bearings and horizontal distances for the surveyed lines are given in these field notes. Unless described, each corner is monumented with a standard iron post 30 inches long, 2-1/2 inches diameter, flanged at the base and with a brass cap riveted to the top.

The geographic position of the Southeast corner of the township is: Latitude 32°41'11" North, and Longitude, 109°06'57.4" West, as taken from the survey plat accepted March 13, 1963, Township 8 South, Pange 31 East.

The mean magnetic declination was found to be 13° East.

	The area surveyed in Township 8 South, Range 31 East lies adjacent to Duncan, Arizona. The land within the township is rolling hills. The elevation ranges from 3,500 feet above sea level in the northeast portion of the township to 4,400 feet at the highest point in section 32.		
	The soil of the township is rocky, gravelly and sandy clay loam. The vegetation consists of creosote, cacti and bunch grass.		

CHAINS

The Gila River enters the township at the northeast portion of section 13, meanders northwesterly and leaves at the north boundary in section 4. The Southern Pacific Railroad parallels the Gila River. State Highway No. 75 enters the township on the east boundary in section 12, traverses northwesterly and leaves at the north boundary in section 3. U.S. Highway No. 70 enters the township at the east boundary in section 13, traverses northwest for approximately  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles, curves to the southwest to a point near the  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner of sections 21 and 22.

There are residences along the Gila River area. The State Highway Department has a maintenance station in section 14. There is a Landing Air Strip in section 36 and underground pipe lines in several sections.

The drainage in the south part of the township is northeasterly and the northeast portion is southwesterly to the Gila River.

Land is used primarily for grazing except along the Gila River, it is under cultivation.
