CHAINS

A History of Previous Surveys: The Fifth Standard Parallel North, Range 3 East, was dependently resurveyed by Horace M. Muscott, survey commenced September 24, 1940, completed June 30, 1941. The subdivision lines were dependently resurveyed by Claude F. Warner, in August 1941, as shown upon the official plat, approved January 28, 1946 and accepted July 8, 1946.

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the Fifth Standard Parallel North, through Range 3 East (the south boundary of the township) and a portion of the subdivision lines, and the survey of a portion of the subdivision lines in a number of sections, Township 21 North, Range 3 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

The dependent resurvey and survey were executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, and the special instructions dated February 16, 1967.

The directions of all lines of this survey were determined by direct altitude observation on the sun, for azimuth and carried forward by normal transit traverse. Distances are expressed in chains, reduced to horizontal equivalents.

The data furnished with the special instructions give the geographic position of the standard corner of sections 35 and 36, as: Latitude 35° 08.9' N., and Longitude 112° 02.1' W., mean magnetic declination $14\frac{1}{2}$ ° East.
