South Boundary and Subdivisional Lines (Resurvey)

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1947, the Special Instructions dated March 23, 1973, and the Supplemental Special Instructions dated April 13, 1973.

Before restoring the corners the lines of the original surveys were retraced and a diligent search made for any evidence of the original corners, bearing trees, and calls of the original field notes. When duly identified, the corner positions were remonumented and new accessories obtained. Lost corners were reestablished at proportionate positions, but not until exhausting every reasonable possibility of finding direct evidence of the control of each corner. For simplification of the record, only the true line notes are furnished.

The directions of all lines were determined by use of the solar transit and refer to the true meridian. The lines were carried by transit method and confirmed by altitude observations of the sun.

The geographic position of the corner of sections 23, 24, 25, and 26, as determined from United States Geological Survey "Iron Springs", Quadrangle, is:

Latitude 34° 39.4' N. Longitude 112° 32.1' W.

The observed mean magnetic declination is  $15\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  East.

CHAINS

The area encompassed by this survey varies from rough, broken land with large, rounded granite boulders to nearly level pasture land. The vegetation consists of scrub oak on the broken ridges, juniper and pinon on the higher elevations and cottonwood and willows along the drainages. The open areas on the lower elevations are covered with native grasses. Mint Wash drains the area from the southeast corner of section 23 to the northwest corner of section 4, with numerous draws and small canyons draining into it.

There are several houses in sections 3 and 11, and extensive subdivision developments in the northeast quarter of section 23 and the west half of section 24. A paved county road runs generally north and south along the east edge of the area surveyed.
