CHAINS

Portions of the east and south boundaries and subdivisional lines and the meanders of the left bank of the Colorado River were surveyed by Theodore F. White in 1874, and resurveyed by Arthur W. Brown and William H. Thorn in 1918-20. Brown and Thorn surveyed the extension of the east boundary and a portion of the subdivisional lines and the United States Reclamation Service Levee in 1918-20. In 1930 Francis E. Joy retraced portions of the meanders of the left bank of the Colorado River and the U.S.R.S. Levee and resurveyed portions of the east boundary and subdivisional lines. In 1954 Wendell G. Hall resurveyed the east boundary and subdivisional lines, the 1874 meanders of the left bank of the Colorado River, and surveyed the eastern right-of-way lines of the New Yuma Valley Levee and accreted lands. Robert C. Yundt and Leonard W. Murphy resurveyed the south and east boundaries and subdivisional lines together with the survey of accreted lands in 1960-61.

The following field notes describe the dependent resurvey of portions of the east boundary and subdivisional lines, the survey of the subdivisions in section 25, the reestablishment of a portion of the 1874 record meander line, and the survey of the right-of-way of a levee and appurtenant railroad facilities, Township 9 South, Range 25 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications set forth in the <u>Manual of Surveying Instructions</u>, 1973, and the Special Instructions dated March 21, 1975, for Group No. 571, Arizona.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions; lost corners were restored and monumented at proportionate positions based on the original record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein.

The directions of lines were determined by means of foreand backsights and angular deflections from azimuths obtained by direct Polaris observations, and they refer to the true meridian.

The geographic position of the corner of sections 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the east boundary of the township, as scaled from the U. S. Geological Survey quadrangle map "GADSDEN, ARIZONA," prepared in 1965, is as follows:

Latitude 32° 36.6' N., Longitude 114° 46.2' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 14° E.
