**CHAINS** 

The following field notes describe the dependent resurvey of a portion of the east boundary, a portion of the subdivisional lines, and the subdivision of certain sections; and the additional subdivision of section 25, in Township 41 North, Range 8 East, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

Portions of the 10th Standard Parallel North, the north and west boundaries, the subdivisional lines, and the traverse of the right rim of Glen Canyon of the Colorado River were surveyed by Benjamin J. Kinsey, Surveyor, and Elliott Pearson, Transitman, in 1937. Portions of the south and east boundaries, the subdivisional lines, a portion of the Page Townsite boundary, and the meanders of a portion of the Colorado River were surveyed by Robert C. Yundt and Boyd S. Owens, Cadastral Surveyors, in 1959.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the <u>Manual of Surveying Instructions</u>, 1973, and the Special Instructions dated May 9, 1994, and the Supplemental Special Instructions, dated May 19, 1994, for Group No. 773, Arizona.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions; lost corners were restored and monumented at proportionate positions based on the original record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein.

The survey was performed at the request of the National Park Service, under the authority of 43 U.S.C. 772, 43 U.S.C. 1701 et seq., and 31 U.S.C. 1535. The purpose of the survey was to verify and establish monumentation for the Glen Canyon National Recreation boundary.

The directions of all lines were determined by direct hour angle observations on the sun, and refer to the true meridian. Distances and angles were measured with a Lietz Set 4A total station instrument.

The geographic position of the cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31 and 36, on the east boundary of the township, was determined by the technique of static differential positioning using Ashtech models M-XII and MS-XIII. U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey triangulation station "ANTELOPE", was used as the control station. The geographic position is as follows:
