

CHAINS

The following field notes describe the dependent resurvey of the Yavapai-Prescott Indian Reservation (Whipple Barracks Military Addition), the Yavapai Indian Reservation, Act of June 7, 1935, Public No. 117, 74th Congress, 49 Stat. 332, the metes-and-bounds survey of the boundary of the Whipple Veteran's Administration Reservation and Lots 7 and 8, Block 6, Dameron Park Addition and the completion survey of the subdivisional lines within the Yavapai-Prescott Indian Reservation, Township 14 North, Range 2 West, Gila and Salt River Meridian, Arizona.

The history of surveys pertaining to this survey is as follows:

The survey of the subdivision lines of T. 14 N., Rs. 2 and 3 W., Gila and Salt River Meridian, were surveyed by S.W. Foreman, Deputy Surveyor, in 1871.

The survey of the subdivision lines of T. 14 N, R. 2 W., Gila and Salt River Meridian, were surveyed by C. Burton Foster, Deputy Surveyor, in 1875.

The resurvey of Boundaries of the Whipple Barracks Military Reservation, part of the south boundary, part of the east boundary and part of the subdivision lines, T. 14 N., R. 2 W., Gila and Salt River Meridian, were surveyed by Sidney E. Blout, U.S. Cadastral Engineer, 1927-1928.

The resurvey of the 3rd Standard Parallel North, thru R. 2 W., east, west, and north boundaries and part of the subdivision lines, T. 13 N., R. 2 W., Gila and Salt River Meridian, were surveyed by Benjamin J. Kinsey, U.S. Surveyor, in 1930.

The boundary of the Yavapai Indian Reservation, within the Whipple Barracks Military Reservation, T. 14 N., R. 2 W., Gila and Salt River Meridian, were surveyed by Benjamin J. Kinsey, U.S. Surveyor, in 1935.

The dependent resurvey of a portion of the south and west boundaries of the Whipple Barracks Military Reservation and survey of Tract A, T. 14 N., R. 2 W., Gila and Salt River Meridian, were surveyed by Wallace R. Ott, Cadastral Surveyor, 1965-1966.

The retracement of the boundaries and survey of the Division of Tract A into Tracts B and C, and survey of Tract D, T. 14 N., R. 2 W., Gila and Salt River Meridian, were surveyed by Jerold E. Knight, Cadastral Surveyor, 1968.

A Memorandum of Agreement between the Department of the Interior and the Veteran's Administration regarding jurisdiction over certain lands in Yavapai County, Arizona was approved April 11, 1958, with a plat.

Dameron Park Addition was platted in 1926.

CHAINS

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the <u>Manual of Surveying Instructions for the Survey of the Public Lands of the United States</u>, 2009, and the Special Instructions dated April 4, 2013, for Group Number 1116, Arizona.

The true meridian direction and length of all lines were determined by real time kinematic, fast static, and static global positioning system observations using Trimble Navigation 5700 and 5800 model receivers.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the prior surveys were retraced and search was made for all corners. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only true line field notes are given herein.

The "standard monument" referred to in these notes is a stainless steel post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., with a brass cap. Unless otherwise indicated, a magnet in a white plastic case is deposited at the base of the stainless steel post.

Geodetic control was derived from Global Positioning System (GPS) static observations post processed by National Geodetic Survey, Online Positioning User Service (OPUS), utilizing Continuously Operating Reference Stations (CORS) DL1882 AZFL NAU FLAGSTAFF CORS ARP, DN2121 AZPA PEORIA FIREST 195 CORS ARP and AI8820 FERN FERNO MESA CORS ARP. The NAD 83 (CORS96) (EPOCH: 2010), geographic position of Corner No. 4, Whipple Barracks Military Reservation is as follows:
