The following field notes describe the dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary, and a portion of the subdivisional lines, and the subdivision of section 7, Township 4 North, Range 2 West, Gila and Salt River, Arizona.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey is as follows:

In 1894, the west boundary was surveyed by Albert T. Colton, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, recorded in book 1266. In 1917, Woodbury Abbey, U.S. Surveyor, and others, resurveyed and retraced the west boundary, recorded in book 3042.

The subdivisional lines were surveyed by Albert T. Colton in 1894, recorded in books 1017 and 1102.

The W 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of section 7, was acquired by the U.S. from the State of Az, under the powers of eminent domain. The Declaration of Taking was executed on 31 December 1952, recorded under Civil Case No. 1757.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications as set forth in the <u>Manual of Instructions for the Survey of the Public Lands of the United States</u>, 2009, and the Special Instructions dated October 24, 2019, for Group Number 1199, Arizona.

The true meridian direction and length of all lines were determined by real time kinematic global positioning system observations using Trimble Navigation R10-2 model receivers.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the prior surveys were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. Lost corners were reestablished and remonumented at proportionate positions based on the official record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein.

Geodetic control was derived from Global Positioning System (GPS) static observations post processed by National Geodetic Survey, Online Positioning User Service (OPUS), utilizing Continuously Operating Reference Stations DN4496 AZUP USERY MOUNTAIN PK CORS ARP, DL6010 AZSV STAR VALLEY CORS ARP, DN6063 AZST SAN TAN PARK CORS ARP.

From this cor., the corner of woven wire fences, enclosing the Ford Motor Company proving grounds bears N. 65° E., 7 lks. dist. Fences extending E. and S.

N. $0^{\circ}01'$ W., bet. secs. 7 and 12 on the W. bdy. of the tp.

No. 25070, as per an Arizona Land Survey Corner Record, filed with Maricopa County Recorder's Office (hereinafter MCRO). Remonumented in 1995 by Maricopa County Department of Transportation (hereinafter MCDOT), with a 3 ins. diam., brass cap, set 8 ins. below the surface, seated in a cast iron survey well, 10 ins. diam. Brass cap is mkd. Maricopa County D.O.T. T4N R2W 1/4 S6 S7 1995. Accepted as the best available evidence of the orig. cor.

Cor. is located beneath the pavement of Happy Valley Road, (26 ft. wide, bears E. and W).
